Officers from the Newport Beach Police Department will conduct a controlled experiment called a "wet lab," to show the negative effects of alcohol on driving.

During this wet lab, 5 to 8 volunteers will be given alcohol, field sobriety tests, and breathalyzer tests at regular intervals to show you the effects of alcohol on driving abilities. This course not only fulfills the entire one-hour requirement for competence credit, but it will also educate you on the increasing levels of alcohol impairment and the tests used to determine a DUI.

Wet lab volunteers will be required to bring a designated driver or use a car service. (Selection is not guaranteed.)
